Agenda Items Discussed:

SIP Review

Teacher Engagement Survey – Shane Musich handed out a copy of the results for the Villas Employee Engagement Gallup survey. (Goal 1) The teachers are asked to complete the survey at the End of each Quarter. He reviewed the results and discussed why there may be a drop in some of the questions.

STAR Reading MGR – (Goal 3) Mr. Musich shared with us on the computer screen, the print out of the 15/16 AR results for Q1 and Q2. Our goal is to be at 70% by the end-of-the-year. At the end of Q2, Kindergarten had already reached 83% success. First grade is at 58%, Second grade is at 65%, Third grade is 54%, fourth grade is at 46% and Fifth grade is at 60%. All grades total is 61% success.

AR - (Goal 2) Shane shared a hand-out of the 15/16 AR results between Q1 and Q2. Kindergarten is doing AR using the Castle Standards. First grade is at 85%, Second grade is at 62%, Third grade is at 45%, Fourth grade at 50% and Fifth grade at 74%.
